Lib Dems oppose 5% Council Tax Hike Council have over £40M in reserves



Gateshead Council have set a budget for the year ahead. Key features include:

- Council tax will increase by 4.99%, the highest increase allowed without a referendum
- Labour have put up council tax by almost 5% when the council already has £41 million in reserves.
- People in Gateshead are paying the highest council tax (Band D) of any metropolitan council.

Lib Dems put forward a motion at the Annual Budget meeting to freeze Council tax by using £4.8M from reserves - to give the people of Gateshead a break this year. This was voted down by the Labour run Council by 47 votes to 11.

Planning updates



Permission is being sought to have an off-license for the site of the former 3Ts Public House in Swalwell.

The decision as to what happens next with this building is now with the Secretary of State for Housing, Communities and Local Government. A hearing will be held later in the year and your ward councillors will be appearing at the hearing.



Lib Dem - Six to Fix



On 6th May, you will be able to vote in the local elections. The Lib Dem "Six to Fix" priorities for our area are:

- 1. Scrap the Council Tax increase.
- 2. **End Labour waste.** There are far too many examples of

wasteful spending by Labour. That has to end.

- 3. **Making Gateshead the green capital of the region** by planting more woodland, saving the greenbelt and stopping traffic measures that often cause more pollution and congestion.
- 4. **Providing homes that people need -** not executive houses that many can't afford.
- 5. **Revitalise Gateshead High Street.** For years the Council has neglected the High Street. Lib Dems will work with developers to regenerate it.
- 6. Improving street cleaning Gateshead has only one dog warden and spends the least on street cleaning in Tyne and Wear.
