PCC Election Result



 Cllr. Jonathan Wallace who stood in the Police Commissioner elections - and called for the position to be abolished to save taxpayers money.

Labour's Kim McGuinness has been elected as PCC for Northumbria. The role became vacant when Vera Baird left the role, despite having another 11 months to serve.

Lib Dems chose Cllr. Jonathan Wallace, as their candidate, who campaigned to abolish the post.

"The PCC role is an expensive experiment that has failed," said Jonathan. "Instead of paying someone £85,000 a year, and splashing out a shocking £2.5 million on a by-election to fill an 11 month vacancy, that money could have been used on community policing which has been slashed by Labour's PCC.



Lighting up Whickham raise the funding for Whickham tree and the group held their Summer Fayre in July.

It was very successful and many of the Whickham councillors went along to help with the event.





Changes to Bus Services Announced

- 97 has been revised to operate every 15 minutes between Newcastle, Gateshead, Lobley HIII, Whickham, Swalwell and Metrocentre on the current route. From Metrocentre, the 97 has been extended to Newcastle via Dunston Riverside and Teams creating a circular route which is running in both directions.
- **97A** has been withdrawn
- The 643 has been taken out of service by Nexus. This service has been replaced in 2 parts by changes to the 6 and M8.
- M8 is now going to Metro Centre via Whickham Front Street, Duckpool Lane and Lambton Avenue instead of Swalwell Bank, covering part of Nexus service 643.
- 6 is now only operating half hourly between Newcastle, Metrocentre, Whickham and Sunniside with one service an hour continuing to Stanley. The journeys which terminate in Sunniside are now serving the Watergate Estate, covering the other part of 643 route.
- X30 The X30 has been extended to run later in the evening with the last bus leaving Eldon Square at 23:25 Monday to Saturday. Sunday's timetable has remained the same. The X30 continues to run half hourly to Stanley with one of the journeys extended to Consett via Annfield Plain.
- M6 is now running half hourly with the service being extended to Lanchester once an hour via Quaking Houses, Burnhope and Maiden Law. The other service terminates at Quaking Houses once an hour.
- **M7** Service has been withdrawn.

New 197 Whickham Circular

Following feedback from your ward councillors and residents, Go North East have introduced a new off-peak local service around Whickham to maintain local connections, serving Front Street, Rectory Lane, Whaggs Lane, Broadway, Parkway and Front Street. The service operates clockwise providing a connection to the shops every 20 minutes between 910 and 1410 Monday to Saturday (St Mary's Green times).

This new service will be reviewed by Go North East after 12/18 months so residents need to use it or risk losing it.
